FAMILY PROMISE

This is a new alliance of 20+ church congregations, Protestant and Catholic, who have joined together to fight against homelessness in our area. Family Promise will assist families with children who are temporarily homeless due to fire, loss of job, etc; honest people who just need a time to get their lives in order. Host Congregations will provide housing in their Church environs for 1 week, and then the families rotate to the next church. Families will be given shelter for about 2 months, depending on need.

Volunteers will provide a hot evening meal, sack lunch, and cold breakfast. In the morning the families will be transported to Family Promise Day Care in a Family Promise van where the parents will begin networking for jobs, homes, etc., and the children will be taken to school. This ministry is a blessing, an opportunity for those who participate to obey Jesus' command to feed the hungry and take care of those in need. JGS partners with St. Paschal, who will provide housing in their old school building; JGS will provide the meals. We are looking for volunteers (August 16-22) to provide and serve one evening meal and couples willing to stay overnight with our guests at St. Paschal's shelter. There will be a meeting of all volunteers on Wednesday, July 22nd, 6:30 P.M. at St. Paschal. Attendance is not obligatory, but please consider being a part of this.
